Training

We run a number of regular training programmes that includes an Introductory Course plus a Professional Training divided into two parts, PT1 and PT2. We have successfully run the Introductory Courses and the first part of the Professional Training programme, although the second part has proved more problematic, which is what happened under the regime of the old SR Foundation. The difficulty has been getting a sufficient number of students to commit to a specific date. We are looking to how this can be achieved so that students who wish to obtain a Diploma in Spirit Release can do so.

On-Line Training

One of the intentions when the Forum was established was to make the courses available to an International clientele. Other Training Courses

Tom Zinser Training

In addition to the general courses that we run we have also hosted a number of other specific training programmes. The first of these was a day event run by Dr Tom Zinser on a special trip from the States, held in 2012. This proved a popular event and we followed this up last year with a three day training event held in Malvern, which was attended by over twenty participants. Tom was able to take us through his various techniques and to demonstrate the methods he used for accessing the wisdom of the Higher-Self. I felt that those who were used to working in a hypnotherapeutic way appreciated his techniques more than those who tended to work through their intuitive sense. Personally I have found his methods, and the insights from Gerod, to be very inspiring although I cannot get on with the use of finger signals. With many of my clients I use Skype or the phone and this precludes ideo-motor signalling. I have found however that the Higher-Self (H-S) is able to communicate very successfully through images, verbal messages, emotional feelings or sensations and from this response I am able to then, with the aid of the H-S to help clients clear the issues or problems stemming from spirit attachment or sub-personalities.

Other Conferences

Over the space of the year I attended one or two conferences that were relevant to spirit release therapy. The first of these was held on Friday 20th September 2013, in London under the auspices of

the 'Ethnic Health Initiative'. The title was 'Spirit Release and Mental Health'. This conference was enlightening in that most of the speakers had little direct experience in spirit release techniques and were most interested in presenting the themes from an anthropomorphic perspective. It highlighted for me how much more work is required in educating the medical profession and others about the significance of spirit attachment in the areas of mental health. London Healing Days

The 'London Healing' days have been run twice a year for the past few years and entail visiting different parts of the capital with the intention of carrying out landscape and earth energy healing work as well as the release of trapped or 'earthbound' spirits. We normally have groups between fifteen to twenty people and the day entails part walking part tube travel to connect to different parts of the city.

In past times we have visited Kensington Palace and the Tower of London, whilst the last trip in September entailed visiting the Houses of Parliament and Westminster Abbey. In those places where disturbances were found the group would meditate together to help lift and clear any stuck or negative energies. In the Spring 2013 part of the trip entailed connecting to the Old Bailey, which was on the site of the Newgate prison. There was a very disturbed energy present that held a number of spirits trapped. This was subsequently cleared by one of the groups that I work with using distant healing techniques.
